#### **SCHEDULE 3 – RECOMMENDED CLAUSES**

### **FUTURE DISPUTES**

Parties to a contract who wish to have any future disputes referred to mediation under the MCCIA Mediation Rules may insert a dispute resolution clause in the contract, using any one of following model clauses, according to their requirement.

#### SUGGESTED MEDIATION CLAUSE

"In the event of a dispute arising out of or relating to this contract, including any question regarding its existence, validity, interpretation or termination, the parties shall seek settlement of that dispute by mediation in accordance with the MCCIA Mediation Rules, which Rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference into this clause."
